

ESSER III PLAN USES OF FUNDS

WAPANUCKA PUBLIC SCHOOL

Wapanucka Public School has engaged in meaningful consultation with stakeholders through in person collaboration to develop an ESSER III uses of funds plan. The plan was devised from information collected during consultation.

- Wapanucka School will use ESSER III funds to implement prevention and of COVID and follow CDC guidelines on reopening schools in a safe manner and conduct in-person learning.
- Wapanucka School will use ESSER III funds to repair and replace existing HVAC systems throughout the school and install a new HVAC unit in the gymnasium to provide better air circulation. The district will also purchase air purifiers for all areas in each building, and purchase commercial floor cleaning machines.
- Monthly utility costs to reduce General Fund balance if a decrease in enrollment should occur due to COVID.
- Wapanucka School will implement additional paraprofessionals to provide remediation for students not making adequate progress due to COVID. We will also offer an extended after-school program and summer school for students who are not making adequate progress to close the instructional gap due to COVID. Educational technology, hardware and software connectivity and printers will also be purchased.
- Training and professional development for all staff on sanitation and minimizing the spread of COVID.
- Wapanucka Public School will spend its remaining ARP ESSER III funds consistent with the uses authorized in Section 2001(e) of the ARP Act. The remaining amount, after reserving 20% for academic loss, will be spent following all guidelines put into place by the Oklahoma State Department of Education.
